President's Report

The Club has made significant progress during the 2001 season with competitive teams at all levels. The end result of one premiership team, two runners-up and two other teams in the finals out of six teams belies just how competitive we were, in all grades. It was certainly a great improvement over the year 2000. We won the Vili's Cup pre-season competition and the Club Championship. How great would it have been with one more premiership?

One of the most important aspects of many team sports, where an entire season is used to determine a winner, is the fact that it is a week to week slog. Our new senior coach Darren Denneman said at the beginning of the home and away matches that the season consisted of three stages - the pre-season, the home and away games and the finals. We had a fantastic pre-season and a very successful home and away campaign, in most grades, that allowed our teams to get a shot at the finals. By the end of the season we had given ourselves four realistic chances of winning premierships, however, we only won one.

Congratulations to the Thirds on being Premiers. They had a crackerjack season and were the pacesetters in all areas. They were well coached by Leigh Taffe, had the competition leading goal-kicker in Dean Knight and Jason Moore was the runner-up in the competition best and fairest award.

The senior team couldn't quite get over the line in their Grand Final, although they gave it their all in the last half. There were left to rue several missed opportunities. It is hoped that the experience will give them more resolve to go all the way next year.

Congratulations to Steve Mahar on his

Mulrooney Medal win. I think he will win a few more before he is finished! Congratulations to all the Club trophy winners.

The on-field improvement this year emanated from some important changes that we made and some very astute recruit selections (thanks to Peter Taylor, Ray Baguley and Duane Rek). Our new coach, Darren Denneman, proved to be an excellent choice to take the reins of our still young team. He led from the front and turned the 'also rans' from last year into a very positive, attacking, skilful, running side that quickly established its credentials as the big improvers in the competition. There is a lot more improvement in the team and we will see this come out in the 2002 and 2003 seasons. In 2002, maybe it's *"Time to Deliver"*.

We recruited a number of new and highly talented players to our senior ranks this year. Players such as 'Frosty' Blizzard, 'Snake' Campbell, 'Freedles' Friedlied, Danny George, 'Knuckles' Habel, 'D2' Hallandale, 'Teepee' Holman, Sam McGuire, 'Munchkin' Reid and Phil Younger fitted in very well, both on and off the field.

The under 18s had a good year but could not match their nemesis, Marist, in the Grand Final. The women's team did well throughout the year and won a final. Development Squad finished in the four but never reached top gear, at any stage. The fourths were competitive without being a threat to the top teams (some of who should have played in third grade!).

milestones as are Adam Ryder and David Coupe on reaching 50 games.

We have also improved our performance off the field. Last year we decided that we had to improve in a number of areas. We appointed an additional full-time member of staff, Duane Rek, to help us in this area. He has proved to be a very valuable contributor and back-up for long-term stalwart, Ray Baguley.

We have placed our business on a firm planning, action and evaluation base by introducing a Business Plan for the first time. The plan has a vision -

On behalf of the Club Committee, coaches, players and supporters, thank you to all the volunteers that put in an incredible amount of work throughout the year to field our six teams. There are too many of you to mention is this small space and I would hate to miss anyone out. You are all an essential part of the fabric of the Club and it could not function without you.

Obviously, the corner stone of our continued growth and improvement is our relationship with the Magpies Sports Club. Thank you to John Kimball, Jon Burrows and the Board for your continued support. As the licensed Club prospers then our prosperity will follow.

We have continued to grow the other essential parts of our business. We have attracted many new sponsors this year and we are particularly happy that The IMB came on board during the season as a major sponsor. We must improve in this area to take the heat off our other income sources.

Our fund raising efforts have continued with strong performances in all areas. All functions were well attended and the hard work on the raffles has continued to bear fruit. Reserve Grade

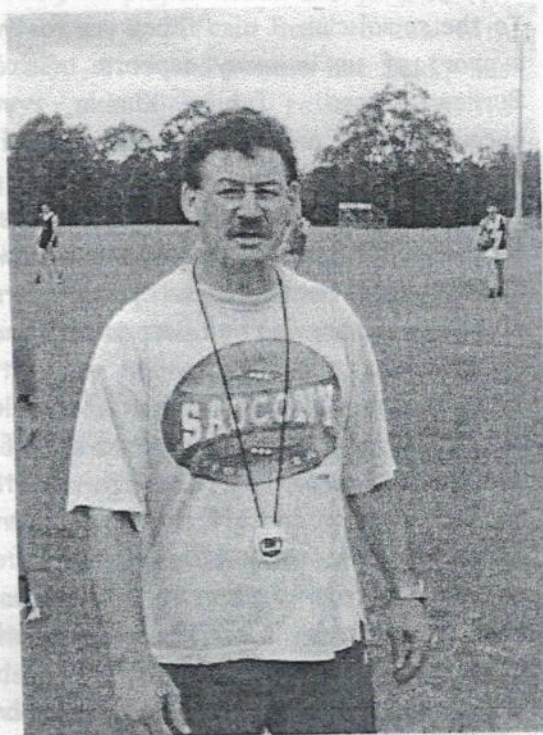

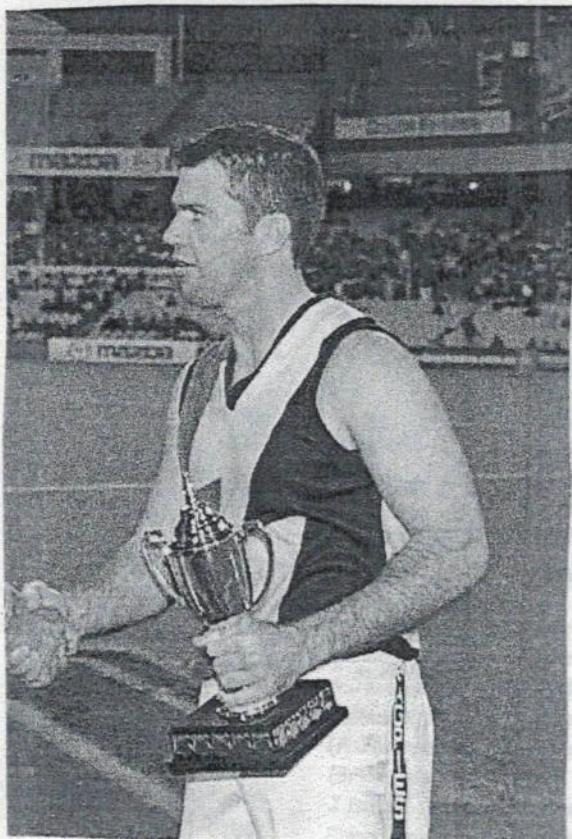

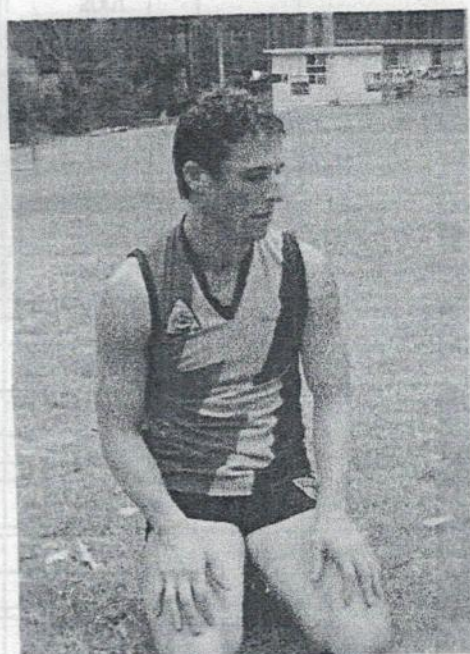
